Insurer SAIF Corporation terminated claimant's eligibility for vocational assistance for his alleged failure to timely provide required information in response to a warning letter. OAR 436-120-0350(9).<sup>1</sup> The Employment Services Team (EST) upheld SAIF's decision in its August 13, 2008 Director's Review and Order. Following a hearing, Administrative Law Judge Chuck Mundorff affirmed EST's order in his April 15, 2009 Proposed and Final Order. The issue on review is whether claimant timely responded to SAIF's warning letter. I affirm and adopt the EST's and the ALJ's orders finding claimant's eligibility for vocational services was properly terminated.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** ALJ Mundorff's April 15, 2009 Proposed and Final Order and EST's August 13, 2008 Director's Review and Order are affirmed and adopted.

A worker is ineligible or the worker's eligibility ends when any of the following conditions apply:  
\* \* \* \* \*

(9) The worker has failed, after written warning, to . . . provide relevant information.
